Freud (in Bertens , 2005:32), explains that  $\it{The\ id}$  is the most basic psychic layer and is the domain of  $\it{Eros}$  and  $\it{Thanatos}$ . in power.  $\it{I}\ d$  is located in the section unconscious become a source of psychic energy and instincts that pressure humans to fulfill basic needs such as need will eating, and sex. How  $\it{ID}$  works related to the principle of pleasure, namely always seeking pleasure and avoiding it discomfort .  $\it{The\ ego}$  is a personality system that acts as an individual's director, located between the conscious and unconscious realms . Serves as a mediator who reconciles the demands of the superego's impulses and prohibitions .  $\it{Ego}$  is in the hands of two opposing forces and is maintained and obedient to the principle of reality .

Located between the conscious and subconscious realms. Task ego is make room for function reasoning, problem solving and decision-making n. *The superego* is a personality system that contains values or rules of an evaluative nature, located partly in the conscious and partly in the unconscious, tasked with monitoring and preventing satisfaction. *Id. That's why Wira hates rain so much. Wira try avoid a feeling that really tortures him proven there is a feeling of relief when his view of the rain protected with figure tall. Id as structure very dominant personality Hero . Shadow of the past plays a big role in Wira's mind so that he is disturbed and finds it difficult to carry out his activities.

But, without meaning to, his eyes caught the view outside the window again, where the rain was falling harder and harder, making the leaves no longer visible. Instantly, the sensation returned, punching him hard in the gut and his consciousness. (APSAH, 2016:11)

Wira looked out the window again, and it was indeed raining. This fact brought back memories of the past . When the rain fell, the sensations Wira had always felt returned. Wira couldn't avoid the rain because it was something humans couldn't predict when it would come or when it would stop. So, whether he liked it or not, Wira had to face it. Wira himself closed his eyes for a moment, *hoping he'd been* right in telling this girl. After learning the truth, she'd probably criticize him like everyone else, but that would also make him give up on inviting her to join the club. (APSAH, 2016:116)

The inner conflict experienced by the main character again, as seen in the data above, is doubt about his decision to tell Kayla about his past. Wira himself feels a dilemma about his decision. The ego always expects the right decision and action. The ego works by considering what will happen after making a decision. The good and bad of an action are important to the ego.

Now *Wira is wracked with feelings of guilt*. The feeling of guilt was much stronger than when he kicked Fais before. (APSAH, 2016:228)

Guilt is an inner conflict within him. Wira feels guilty for still being able to compete in taekwondo, while Wira cannot. Wira blames himself for what happened. Ego feels that what Wira has done is a feeling that arises when remembering events in his past.

Wira was looking at her sympathetically when he accidentally glanced at a puddle of water on the asphalt road that was creating longitudinal waves. Wira's heart skipped a beat when he realized it was the raindrops that had caused it. (APSAH, 2016:29)

Based on the data above The inner conflict Wira experienced was already categorized as trauma. Just by looking at the puddles on the asphalt, Wira felt the sensation he felt every time it rained. Wira's heart felt like it stopped beating because of deep fear. Wira realized that the raindrops made him feel that way. However, the ego tried to make Wira continue to exist until now. Although Wira often experienced inner conflict that was categorized as trauma, it did not make Wira think about ending his life. Although Wira's way of maintaining his life was different from that of most people, Wira's ability to deal with his past trauma is worthy of appreciation. Therefore, the superego plays a very important role in the formation of Wira's id and ego.

Wira felt anxious because it meant meeting new people, and he didn't know how to get the photo. (APSAH, 2016:62)

Based on the data above, Wira feels anxious because of the orientation assignment from his campus. Wira and his friends are required to fill out the biodata of their campus friends. This means that Wira must get to know the people whose biodata Wira will fill out. Wira's internal conflict is the anxiety of having to get to know new people who might judge him if they know about his past. Ego tries to find a way to avoid this. Wira does not want his friends to know the events in his past that make them avoid him.

Hero...what has hero been doing all this time Ma. *Wira shook his head in frustration*. At a time when Faiz could n't go to college anymore. can no longer practice taekwondo. What is Hero doing Maa? (APSAH, 2016:230)

Wira continues to blame himself for Faiz's death, even though medically it was declared that Faiz died suddenly from a sudden heart attack. However, that reality doesn't make Wira feel better.

Every person reacts differently to comforting; some are receptive, while others are not. Therefore, conflict with oneself can have significant consequences, impacting a person's mental development and survival.

Ego made Wira realize that he was truly not okay. Wira continued to find fault with Faiz's death, but Wira refused to hear any comfort. Wira only wanted to grieve. But as time went on , Wira decided and mustered up the courage to meet Faiz's mother. Wira's decision was not in vain. Through Faiz's parents' explanation, Wira now accepted that Faiz had indeed died of a sudden heart attack, not because of the match with him.

# c. Superego

A few months ago, he swore to abandon taekwondo completely. *However, today, he broke his vow*. This happened because he had pretended to be a hero. He shouldn't have interfered in other people's affairs. His own life was already in disarray. ( APSAH, 2016:29 )

The superego encourages Wira to help his friend from being harassed by thugs using his taekwondo skills. Although Wira realizes that his actions violate his past promise to completely leave the world of taekwondo. However, his heart refuses to see others in danger. The id seems to tell him to appear indifferent to the incident before his eyes, but the superego encourages him to help the girl. Although initially the id thinks that he should not interfere in other people's affairs, the superego plays a role in his mind and overcomes the id .

However thus felt that his oath That no too right. Wira changed thought so he came back willing play taekwondo. Here seen There is change values held by the character main. Wira sighed . Without to the best of his knowledge, the grandmother equips him umbrella. Although Hero gives thanks Because Her grandmother so attention to him, he No will Once use umbrella that. Because of the umbrella That not Can protect it from rain. No anyone can. (APSAH, 2016:23)

So long Wira stick to one's opinion that umbrella No Can protect it. It means that although he uses umbrella as protector No will remove shadow departure Faiz. Even umbrella No will relieve sadness and guilt. So strong opinion That was on his mind so that No will use umbrella, although actually his ego (consciousness) accepts that giving her grandmother that is umbrella is sign love unfortunately. Wira moment That controlled by his superego.

towards the campus gate even though in his chest cavity, his heart was pounding violently . Behind them, the man just stared. (APSAH, 2016:28)

Based on the data above, Wira's superego is again shown by displaying a polite attitude towards the thug who blocked the girl, Wira did this to avoid a fight between himself and the thug. The superego is

Flashes of the past that resurface within Wira keep him awake at night. He accidentally falls asleep in class during a statics lesson, prompting his professor to tease him, but Wira remains unmoved . but Hero aware that what he did is A wrong action. so, personality superego in self-Hero make it realize that what he did is something is wrong, with thus Hero No feel true and willing to apologize to the lecturer concerned immediately *regretted his decision not to bring a change of clothes.* (APSAH, 2016:144)

The superego makes Wira aware of his mistake, that his decision not to bring a change of clothes to taekwondo practice was the wrong one. Wira regrets his mistake, and from this regret, it is clear that Wira will not make the same mistake again. The superego appears as something that pushes Wira to realize his mistake.

"I promise Iz, me promise," said Wira Then ..." I promise I will life with taekwondo. Your dreams, your dreams me, my ambition We before. I promise will try get it (APSAH, 2016:27 2)

There is a thought that has been This control figure main that is Hero namely his oath for leaving taekwondo. Actually, the thoughts that dominate him is an uncontrollable urge realized from his instincts For Want to forgetting past trauma. After the ego takes control again then the superego is visible return namely figure Hero speak out his ambitions in connection with taekwondo game. Even promise for try reach the medal he coveted as proof his abilities in taekwondo field.

## Conclusion

Based on analysis on the part the previous so can withdraw conclusion as following Conflict inner experiences figure main in *the* novel *Anything but Rain* background behind by past trauma. Events death his best friend Faiz, the tragic one leaving lingering guilt in self-Hero. Based on psychoanalysis, structure personality Hero each other clash cause conflict happen in self-Hero. Consequences conflict the Finally Hero difficult adapt with condition, no believe self for fight, no brave take decisions, and always plagued by feelings of sadness and worry. *Superego* present For control action *id* . Finally, Hero return mastered his ego and can accept condition after accept advice in the form of values from Mother Faiz that everyone has guilty and should Hero Study forgive self alone. Advice from Mother Faiz is the *superego* area that is capable of subdue *id* Hero.
